

A GLANCE OF THE SITES WE'LL VISIT



Barcelona is located on the west coast of Spain We will visit the Gothic Quarter and the 'Spanish Village' with reproductions of the most typical buildings in Spain. Next we will visit the Basilica of the Sagrada Familia, one of the largest churches in Europe and a magnificent arquitectural work of art. We will also walk thru Las Ramblas Boulevard, one of the most upbeat, striking boulevards in Europe.



Valencia is situated on the banks of the Turia, on the east coast of the Iberian Peninsula, fronting the Gulf of Valencia on the Mediterranean Sea. Its historic center is one of the largest in Spain, with ancient monuments, views and cultural attractions. Valencia, the name itself brings up images of Sun, Oranges, and Sand. It is a Perfect place to live and be outside enjoying the River Gardens, sitting at a cafe or exploring the mountains and fields that surround the city.



Granada is a city in southern Spain's Andalusia region, in the foothills of the Sierra Nevada mountains. It's known for grand examples of medieval architecture dating to the Moorish occupation, especially the Alhambra. This sprawling hilltop fortress complex encompasses royal palaces, serene patios, and reflecting pools from the Nasrid dynasty, as well as the fountains and orchards of the Generalife Gardens.



Seville is the capital of southern Spain's Andalusia region and a hotbed for flamenco dance, especially in the Triana neighborhood. The city is known for its ornate Alcázar castle complex, built during the Moorish Almohad dynasty, and its 18th-century Plaza de Toros de la Real Maestranza bullring. The massive Gothic cathedral is the site of Christopher Columbus's tomb and a famous minaret turned belltower, the Giralda.



Madrid is is the capital of Spain, a city of elegant boulevards and expansive, manicured parks. It is located in the heart of the Iberian Peninsula with a population of over 3 million. Madrid is a cosmopolitan city and the headquarters for the Public Administration, Government, Spanish Parliament and the home of the Spanish Royal Family. The city is characterized by an intense cultural and artistic activity including museums & monuments of extraordinary beauty and it is renowned for its rich repositories of European art, including the Prado Museum's works by Goya, Velázquez and other Spanish masters. The heart of old Hapsburg Madrid is the porticolined Plaza Mayor, and nearby is the baroque Royal Palace
